The Missouri Council for History Education is planning its 16th annual conference focusing on the best practices in history education. We invite you to submit a breakout session proposal. Sessions may feature lessons on episodes in U.S. or World History, curriculum issues facing social studies teachers, technology use in the classroom, or other topics relating to content and methodology. Proposals may include panels, roundtables, and/or workshops. All sessions will be approximately sixty minutes in length.

All presenters must pre-register for the conference and are expected to participate in the full conference. Our conferences are particularly valued because of the collegiality and networking among presenters and educators.

Proposal Guidelines

Proposals must include:

- Title of the session
- Name and contact information for each presenter – ground and email addresses for both the school year and summer as well as your preferred phone numbers
- Information regarding presenters' experience presenting to K-12 educators
- 50 to 100 word abstract indicating information and instructional methodology to be shared
- Specify any audio-visual needs
- Identify intended audience (grade level, subject)
- Presenters intending to promote a particular set of commercial materials, including textbooks and/or supplemental materials, must indicate this in their proposal
